

Savings bank

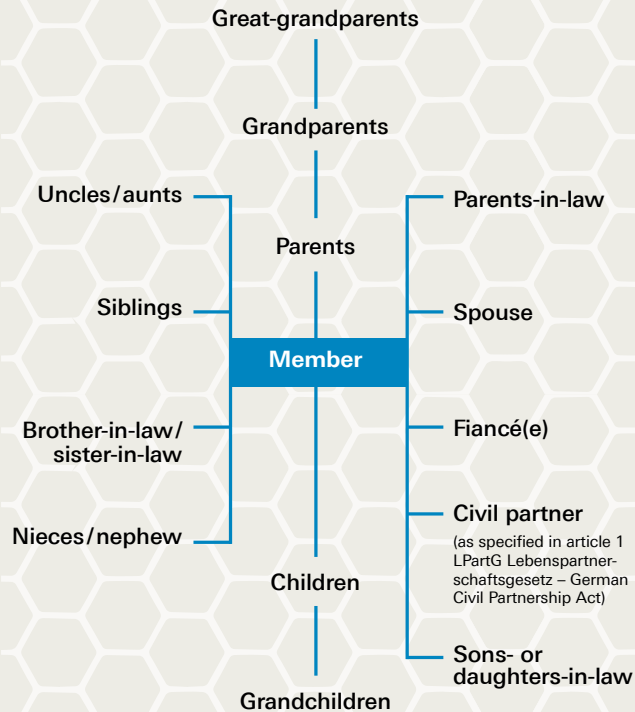
We also offer our members the opportunity to invest their money in our savings bank. It's a facility that used to and still does benefit both our members and the Cooperative.

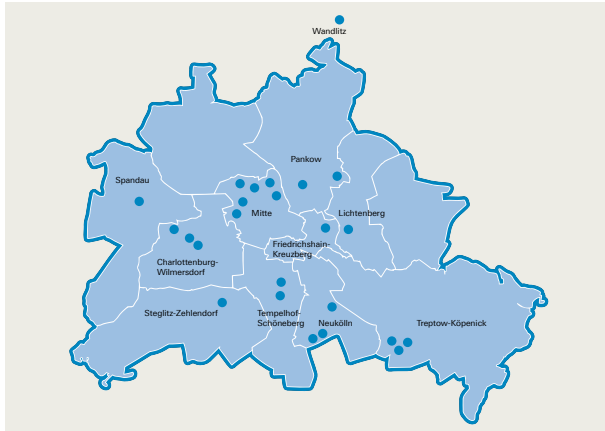

Membership

Living in a cooperative allows you to feel very secure because you have a lifelong right to stay in our property.

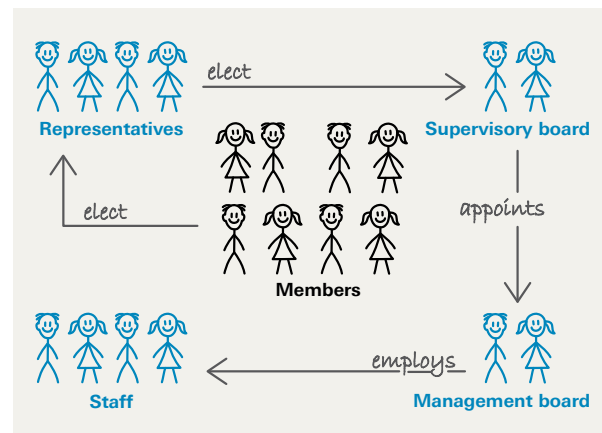
You need to purchase a share in the Cooperative worth of € 300 and an additional entrance fee of currently € 300 to become a member. The entrance fee will not be refunded upon termination of membership. If you rent an

apartment you will need to buy further shares, depending on the size of the apartment.

We are currently only accepting new members related with the signing of a rental contract. The children, grandchildren, parents, grandparents, spouses and civil partners of our members are still welcome as we want to further support the identification with the cooperative idea and the family connection to the cooperative.

Democracy in a cooperative

A key characteristic of a housing cooperative is that members can exercise a voluntary right to have a say and become involved. Our members have this option with regard to the properties themselves and the organisation as a whole.
